


'May the Odds be Ever in Your Company's Favor' for Corporate Knowledge Bowl 2014

Library customers can now enjoy animated and talking picture books among the *Story Books* collection, math stories, read-along chapter books, language learning tools, videos, puzzles and games, and more!

"Story Books bring children's picture books to life with animation and audio narration," explained Library Collection Development Manager Alan Stewart. "Beginning readers can follow along with highlighted words while they listen, or they can turn off the audio and read independently. They can pause their story, rewind it, fast forward, and control the pace," he said.

New 'iPads for Seniors' Classes Coming to Memphis Public Libraries

Seniors visiting Memphis Public Libraries no longer have to rely on kids or grandkids to answer their technology questions. Thanks to a grant from the Durham Foundation and **new** *iPads for Seniors* classes, they can learn for themselves at their own pace.

Coming to various Library locations in **August 2014**, these interactive sessions will offer senior students an opportunity to learn basic functions on an iPad, how to research information, and how to access the Library's e-



book collection. But, the curriculum does not end there. A team of trained instructors will teach seniors button placement on the iPad, how to connect to and navigate Wi-Fi, along with how to snap photos, record video, and share them with friends. Students will take a virtual field trip to the iTunes App Store and learn to install apps on the portable device, which will be provided for the Library's classes. (Students are not required to bring their own iPads.)

Several Library locations will offer the free course along with selected community centers and senior centers.

Customers in the Whitehaven area should stop by the **Whitehaven Branch Library**. Originally staffed by a group of book-loving volunteers, Whitehaven Library first opened in 1953. Fast forward 60 years, and Whitehaven Library is still a staple in its community.

Located at 4120 Millbranch Road, the Library specializes in S.T.E.A.M. -- Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math. Whitehaven Library

customers can find helpful resources in each of these subjects, along with fiction and non-fiction books, reference

material, magazines, newspapers, audiobooks, and more. The Library also offers large print books, movies, and music!

Job search assistance and computer training are available for customers needing help with their career search, and several programs for the whole family are offered each month like "Girls Night Out" for mom, i-pads for teens, and "Handmade Wednesdays" arts and crafts for kids. Dad is sure to enjoy one of Whitehaven Library's 36 public computers or 13 laptop computers for checkout. A specialized workstation is available for visually-impaired guests also.

With lots of space, Whitehaven Library has three study rooms, a meeting room, conference room, and storytime room, making it the ideal place to study or host meetings. The branch is open Mondays - Thursdays, 10 am - 7 pm, and Fridays and Saturdays, 10 am - 5 pm or call (901) 415-2781.
