Thousands Expected to Attend Memphis Public Library's JobLINC Career Fair

Mark your calendar for July 22!

MEMPHIS, Tenn. (July 16, 2015) – Each year, long lines of jobseekers anxiously await the *Memphis Public Library's JobLINC Career Fair* at the **Benjamin L. Hooks Central Library** (3030 Poplar Avenue). This year's event is scheduled for **10 am – 3 pm** on **Wednesday**, July **22**, 2015.

"JobLINC is celebrating 25 years of community service! The career fair serves as a vehicle to connect jobseekers to hiring employers. Customers will speak one-on-one with multiple companies in one setting," explained Robyn Stone, JobLINC Services agency manager. "Dress for success, bring a positive attitude, and plenty of resumes – printed copies and a digital version – so you can apply while at the Library," she advised.

Prior to the career fair, Library customers can sharpen their interview skills at a **career preparation workshop** – *Get the Most From Your Job Fair Experience* – which will offer resume reviews, mock interviews, and information on how to dress. The workshop will be held **Friday, July 17, 10 am – 3 pm**, and **resume review sessions** will be held **3:30 pm – 5 pm** at **Central Library** (room L-56).
